THE JOHN McINERNEY PERPETUAL CHALLENGE TROPHY (74) presented to the best Novice Hunter.

All exhibits in the Hunter classes must be registered with SHB(GB) and the Hunter classes will be judged under SHB(GB) 2008 rules. The Small Hunter class will not be included in the Ridden Hunter Championship.

Classes 2, 3, 4 & 5 are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show and only horses registered on the 2009 Show Hunter Register are eligible to compete. Registration numbers should be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be full members of Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain. The TWO highest placed horses in each class will qualify. Entries for classes 2, 3 and 4 must be registered in the weight class in which they are catalogued, unless an application to change weight class has been received by the SHB(GB) office in time for the office to notify this Show of any change. Only one weight change per season is permitted. All qualifying entries for the Royal International Horse Show must be delivered or sent on or before the closing date (12 June 2009), together with the amount of entry fees and the charges for stabling required. There is no need for competitors to telephone within 24 hours of qualification to state their intention to enter, as in the past, just send entries.

THE NATIONAL HUNTER SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW (NHSCS) - QUALIFYING CLASSES. All Hunter classes will be judged under the Society's rules. Classes 2-5 are qualifying events for this year's NHSCS and only horses registered on the current year Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be members of the SHB(GB). The three highest placed horses in each class will qualify to enter at the NHSCS. No horse lower than third in its class will qualify.

This Show is a qualifier for the BLUE CHIP & IDHS (GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE. The qualifier will be the highest placed horse (not already qualified) in each class, ie

nos 1 to 5, that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register, ie with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding. Horses need not be registered to qualify, but must be on the IDHS(GB) registers by the time of the Championship, which will be held at the IDHS(GB) Annual Breed Show on 19th-20th September 2009 at Weston Lawns Equitation Centre, Bulkington, Coventry, Warks. NB. A horse may only qualify for the Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a rosette and a £10 voucher from Blue Chip. In the Final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money plus a trophy and a Blue Chip rug, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Pure Bred will receive a trophy and £100 and the highest placed 15.2hh and under will receive a trophy and £50

This Show is affiliated to the Ponies Association (UK) (Aff. No. 009/AFF/5651). This Show is a qualifier for the Ponies (UK) 2009 Summer Championship Show, to be held on the 12-15 August 2009 at Newark & Notts Showground. The Ponies (UK) Whittakers Lord Open Hunter Championship – if not already qualified, 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed horses will qualify for the 2009 Ponies (UK) Summer National Championships. Qualification cards will not be presented in the ring. Competitors in qualifying positions, who are NOT current members of Ponies (UK) are allowed 14 days in which to become Members and register their horses in order for the qualification to remain valid. Riders to have attained their 16th birthday by the 1st January of the current year.

Class 6 is a qualifying event for the Royal International Horse Show and only horses registered on the 2009 Show Hunter register are eligible to compete. Registration numbers should be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be full members of Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain. The THREE highest placed horses will qualify. All qualifying entries for the Royal International Horse Show must be delivered or sent on or before the closing date (12 June 2009), together with the amount of entry fees and the charges for stabling required. Late entries will only be accepted from qualifiers at those shows which are held after the closing date for entry.

This Show is a qualifier for the BLUE CHIP & IDHS (GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE. The qualifier will be the highest placed horse (not already qualified) in this class, ie class 6, that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register, ie with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding. Horses need not be registered to qualify, but must be on the IDHS(GB) registers by the time of the Championship, which will be held at the IDHS(GB) Annual Breed Show on 19th-20th September 2009 at Weston Lawns Equitation Centre, Bulkington, Coventry, Warks. NB. A horse may only qualify for the Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a rosette and a £10 voucher from Blue Chip. In the Final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money plus a trophy and a Blue Chip rug, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Pure Bred will receive a trophy and £100 and the highest placed 15.2hh and under will receive a trophy and £50

Exhibitors will now be allowed to enter up to two horses in a Working Hunter Class, but following the jumping phase it will be up to the exhibitor to select ONLY ONE horse to take forward into the ridden and conformation section if required. The minimum height of a Working Hunter is reduced to exceeding 148cms (14.2hh).

THE 'SUTHERLAND' PERPETUAL CHALLENGE CUP (10), presented by His Grace the late Duke of Sutherland, KT, PC, for the winner.

## Method of Judging

To be judged 60% for jumping performance, 40% as for Hunter classes. The jumping to be judged 40% for actual jumping, 20% for style and presence while jumping, 20% for ride, presence and 20% for conformation. Fences to be minimum of eight and a maximum of twelve in number and a maximum of 3ft 9ins in height at the discretion of the judge. Fences to have a natural appearance and not be easily dislodged. The manner of going to be taken into account. Refusals to be severely penalised. No change of rider or tack will be allowed. Grade 'A' showjumpers and Grade 1 eventers are not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show Jumper or Advanced Event Horse as at 1st January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. Exhibitors will jump in catalogue order. All obstacles are to be numbered. Horses may be equipped with boots of a plain colour for the jumping phase only, see SHB(GB) 2009 Rules, ref. ridged or weighted boots.
