FREE CAR PARK

Exhibitors will be supplied with a Green delivery label. This must be
attached to the windscreen of the vehicle making delivery, which
must quit the ground by 9.00am on Show Day. Passengers must
either have admission tickets or pay on entrance. Exhibits arriving
after 9.00am must be carried onto the showground. THE DRIVER
OF THE VEHICLE NEED NOT HOLD AN ADMISSION TICKET,
BUT WILL NEED TO PAY A £10 CASH DEPOSIT AT THE GREEN
ENTRANCE, FOR WHICH HE WILL BE GIVEN A RECEIPT. THIS
AMOUNT WILL BE RETURNED ON LEAVING THE GROUND AT
THE LONDON ROAD EXIT ONLY BEFORE 9.00am. IF THE
DRIVER LEAVES AFTER 9.00am THE DEPOSIT WILL BE
FORFEITED. EXHIBITORS ARE ASKED TO MAKE A NOTE OF
THIS REGULATION.

**To comply with new license conditions to hold a bird
gathering, some new bio-security measures will be
necessary, as follows:**

- i) **Please cleanse and disinfect your show cages, crates or
baskets before the event and be advised that they
should be cleansed and disinfected on return to the
home premises and before they are used to hold any
other bird.**
- ii) **All litter and manure within cages, crates or baskets
must be contained before disposal in a sealed bag and
put in a skip. Public areas to be kept as free from litter
as possible.**
